MEETING- June 17, 2025

EMS Building- 7pm

President Doug Thompson called the meeting to order at 7:03pm.

ROLL CALL: Attendance roster showed 3 officers present and 16 of 34 directors present, representing 14 of the 22 associations.

MINUTES: Arlin Edeal noted a correction in the May meeting minutes: A private contractor, not Dawson Public Power, brought a load of nice, clean mulch into the grass dump. A motion to approve the corrected minutes from the May 20, 2025, minutes was made by Jane Kirby and seconded by Jack Ortengren. Aye: all.

FINANCIAL REPORT: Motion to approve the financial report was made by Bonnie Hahn, Jane Kirby and seconded by Arlin Edeal Aye: all.

CNPPID REPORT: No representative present from Central.

COMMITTEE REPORTS: **Fireworks:** Fireworks will be held on Saturday, July 5, with a Rain Date of Sunday, July 6. There will be a “surprise” during this year’s fireworks show, commemorating the 25th Anniversary of the show. **Hike & Bike Trail:** The Annual Gazebo Hop on the trail will be held on July 19 starting at 9am. Registration will be held at 8:30am at Restless Waters Events Center. Door prizes will be coordinated with the Johnson Lake Chamber. Four trees were planted. One replacing a tree that died. The Road 428 approach on the east side of the hike and bike trail will be repaired. Those using the hike and bike path may need to use an alternate route for a period of time. A question was asked about repainting the mile markers on the hike and bike trail. Arlin will look into this. **ROADS:** Luke sent an email stating gravel will be placed before July 4th and Labor Day. Contact Ryan Pickel, Vice President for questions or problems with roads in your area. **Mowing:** Doug received a schedule for mowing from Jim Brown. A copy will be emailed to each director. **Grass Dump:** It was asked about the \$750 fine to be placed against those who dumped oversize logs at the dump last month. The offender picked up all the oversize logs and hauled them away, so no fine was assessed. Summer grass dump hours: April 1 thru September 30 7am-8pm.

New Business: Tom Mooberry suggested all areas should go together and put in irrigation wells for fire fighting around the lake and share the cost. Discussion was held. It was stated each area fire department is supposed to have an emergency plan for Johnson Lake. Doug will check with the fire departments to see if area farmers have given access to any of their wells for firefighting purposes around the lake.

ADJOURNMENT: A motion was made to adjourn by Jane Kirby All voted AYE. Meeting adjourned.
