The road will be closed before the show takes place. 4 more trees have been planted this spring for a total of 10 trees along the trail. We will ride from the playground to the Lakeview Acres Gazebo and back. **ROADS:** No report. **DUMP:** Doug spoke about the need for a 20x20 building to be built at the dump, as well as a riding mower. \$620 has been raised to date for this project. He would also like to see an additional security camera placed on the north sides of the lot.
